# Calls for chief executive to resign as government involvement demanded

NICK de Bois is calling for the hospital's chief executive to resign over the "Chase Farm consultation fiasco".

The Conservative parliamentary spokesman for Enfield North is calling residents to arms about the process which has been used to eliminate all six scenarios which included improvements to Chase Farm.

Mr de Bois is sending 40,000 letters to Enfield homes containing a pre-paid return slip for residents to register their objections to hospital plans.

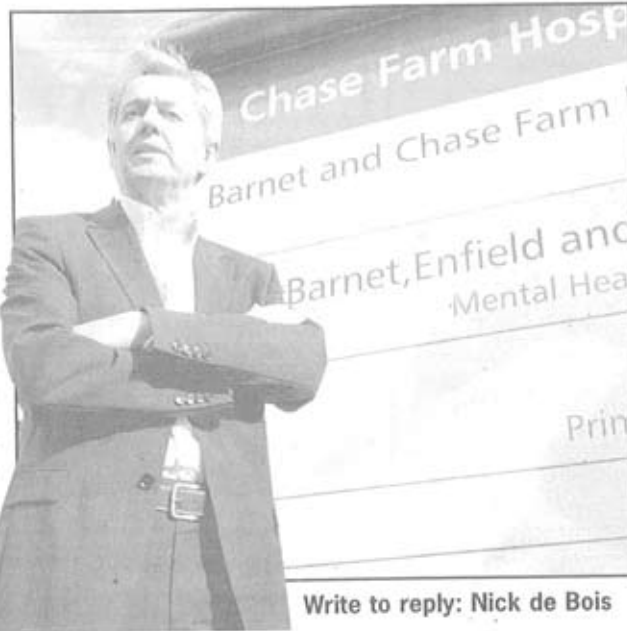
He has also set up a website, [www.saveourhospitals.org](http://www.saveourhospitals.org), which will go online next week.

He told the Advertiser: "This campaign needs to transcend politics.

"I am going to take my campaign, along with the signatures which have already been collected, to health secretary Patricia Hewitt.

"There is no doubt that there is a massive surge of public opinion against these service cuts. It's much larger than Enfield - it's going on all over the country.

"They've already demonstrated that this is not a safe consultation and they have cut

the shortlist with a ruthless disregard for public opinion.

"I certainly think the chief executive, Averil Dongworth, should resign over this fiasco, and the board directors need to take a long hard look at how they have acted."

Enfield North MP Joan Ryan is also highly critical of the hospital's public engagement.

She said: "I don't like the

look of the four remaining options. Enfield loses out every time.

"But it's not about a failing government policy. We want to see services localised. We have to keep an option open to speak to Patricia Hewitt, but it is too early to do that because we don't know what we are dealing with."
