

Enfield Town Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) Final Consultation

If you live in a road that is proposed to be included within the extended boundaries of the Enfield Town CPZ you should have received from the council a map and consultation form for you to fill in and return by Friday 5th August.

To be clear, a CPZ is an area where, during specified hours, only vehicles displaying valid permits will be allowed to park in on-street parking bays. *There is a charge for these permits.*

Neighbouring roads may have been included in the council consultation and we understand that anybody who has written to the council to express a view on the proposed changes should also have received a form to complete.

This proposal is being put forward by the Labour Council and so far, as your local Ward councillors, we have been able to restrict the number of roads that have been included following significant opposition from a large number of residents. It is now very important that if your road is potentially to be included in the extended CPZ, you reply and express your views.

If you live in a road adjacent to the proposed extension of the parking zone you may also wish to express your views to the council.

Enfield Residents Priority Fund

We are pleased to inform you that there is a new initiative from Enfield council in line with the Conservative-led government’s localism agenda!

Town Ward has been allocated a budget of £51,000 from the Enfield Residents Priority Fund. We would like your views on what projects this money should be spent on.

In short, projects that can be eligible for funding must follow a certain criteria; have an impact in the Ward, improve the social, economic and well being of the area or align with the councils aims to tackle deprivation.

Community and neighbourhood groups can **put forward project ideas** to us as Ward councillors.

For example projects can be floral hanging baskets, more dog bins, gum butts

(environment), bicycles for the Police Safer Neighbourhood Team (tackling crime) and more or better play equipment for children in parks swings, slides etc. They can be big bids for big ideas, or smaller bids as little as £500.

We invite you to tick which project areas you feel are important to the ward and return it back to us. If you have a specific idea of what you would like to see given funding, we are especially keen to hear from you.

We will write back informing you of the results of the Ward poll along with the project ideas that have been submitted to us that meet with the poll results and the criteria.
